State CHIP is a free or low-cost state health insurance plan for children. Non-U.S. citizen children with working parents may be eligible.

What does State CHIP cover?

- Well-child exams
- Immunizations
- Doctor visits
- Hospital and emergency care
- Prescriptions
- Hearing and eye exams
- Mental health services
- Dental care

Who may be eligible for State CHIP?

- Non-U.S. citizen who is not a lawfully permanent resident (LPR/Green Card holder)
- Living in Utah for 180 days or more
- Under age 19
- Not currently covered by health insurance
- Not eligible for Medicaid or CHIP
- Meet income requirements (before taxes)
